

2007+ Suzuki SX-4 Rear Skidplate Install Instructions

Hardware:

None, you will reuse your factory hardware

Tools Needed:

Dead blow hammer or jack with a piece of wood.

14mm End wrench

17mm Wrench or Socket

Jack Stands or Car Ramps

A friend to help hand you tools and a cold beer. (nice but not necessary)

Step 1. Place car on jack stands or car ramps, apply parking brake. (PLEASE BE SAFE!)

Step 2. Using your wrenches or sockets remove the 2 front bolts on the side of the rear diff and the two upper bolts on the rear of the diff. You may find it's easier to remove the muffler from the hangers to access the upper bolts. I just pushed it out of the way.

Step 3. Slide your new Primitive Racing skidplate into place and insert the 2 front side bolts. Leave them loose for the moment.

Step 4. Now we need to get the rear of the plate over that lip on the back of the diff. You can either strike the plate with a dead blow hammer or place a piece of wood under the back edge of the plate and use a floor jack to get it over the lip. Once that is done, insert the top bolts through the new plate and tighten them down.

Step 5. Now push the front of the rear plate up as far as it will go in the slotted bolt holes and then tighten the two side bolts till they are nice and snug.

Step 6. That's it. You've installed your new skidplate. Grab some "beverages" and sit back and enjoy your new plate.
